

TRASH PICKUP IN TOWANDA BOROUGH



Borough residents are reminded that trash placed at the curb will be collected as follows:

- Monday – from the south Borough line up to and including Bridge Street (within the Borough)
- Wednesday – all streets north of Bridge Street (within the Borough) up to and including Elm Street
- Friday – all streets north of Elm Street and Mix Avenue to the north Borough line

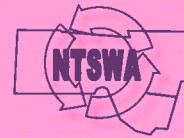
NOTE: Garbage is not to be placed at the curb more than 24 hours before pick up

There are three (3) options for trash pick-up in Towanda Borough:

1. Purchase a Towanda Borough prepaid garbage sticker and apply to each 32-gallon (or smaller) trash can or bag. Cost is \$4.00 per sticker (effective 1/1/23) and can be purchased at these locations:
 - Hurley's Super Market – 93 Reuter Blvd., Towanda (Colonial Plaza)
 - TOPS #680 – 136 Ennis Ln, Towanda (Bradford Towne Plaza – Wysox)
 - Towanda Municipal Building – 724 Main St, Towanda
 - Dandy Mini Mart – Towanda, East Towanda, North Towanda, Wysox – 2 locations, & Monroeton

Towanda Borough - Prepaid Collection/Disposal Payment Sticker

- EACH BAG MUST BE TAGGED.
- PLACE TAG AROUND NECK.
- MAXIMUM BAG SIZE 32 GALLON AND 35 POUND LIMIT.
- RECYCLE TO KEEP THE COST OF TRASH REMOVAL DOWN.

2. Rent a 90-gallon plastic tote/bin with flip-top lid and wheels from NTSWA. This will hold approximately three (3) bags of trash and will be emptied weekly. Cost is \$62.00 per month, billed 1st of each month by NTSWA. To enroll, contact NTSWA:

3. In the C2 Commercial District, dumpsters can also be rented by contacting NTSWA.
 - Note: In accordance with the International Property Maintenance Code, garbage in the C2 Commercial District must always be stored in approved garbage containers. Leaving garbage curbside not in a suitable container is NOT permitted in the C2 Commercial District and subject to fines. It is the responsibility of the Property Owner, NOT the tenant, to supply the approved garbage containers.

Questions regarding pick up or to make special arrangements for loose trash pick-up can be made by calling **570-297-4177** to schedule pick-up day and the rate. A spring cleanup (NO household garbage) is held in May each year with free (some exclusions) drop-off at the sewer plant or picked up curbside by NTSWA for a reduced fee.
