Recycling Guidelines

Category:	
Aluminum Cans:	Empty and rinse cans. No food residue. Keep separate from tin. Crushing is optional but saves space.
Clear Glass:	Food and beverage bottles & jars only. Keep clear separate from colored. Remove lids and rings. Rinse well. No food residue. Labels can remain.
Colored Glass:	Food and beverage bottles & jars only. Keep colored separate from clear. Remove lids and rings. Rinse well. No food residue. Labels can remain.
**Corrugated Cardboard:	Flatten boxes & keep dry. Remove all plastic wrap and packing material such as Styrofoam, foam peanuts, air pillows, etc. No paperboard such as cereal/tissue boxes. No waxy or greasy cardboard.
Mixed Paper:	Includes junk mail, magazines, catalogs, newspaper, paperback books, colored paper, shredded paper. Keep dry. Do not bundle, bag or tie.
Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Jars, Tubs:	Recycle only these shapes (bottles, jugs, jars & tubs). Includes water & soda bottles, laundry and milk jugs, shampoo bottles, yogurt container, butter tubs. Empty and Rinse. No food residue. Lids can remain. Crush to save space. * Bagging plastics for curbside collection is acceptable*** No black plastic, No flower pots, No hard/bulky plastic, No plastic bags, No oil containers, No Styrofoam
Steel/"Tin" Cans:	Rinse and secure lids inside. No food residue. Keep separate from aluminum. Labels can remain.

****DUE TO INCREASED VOLUMES WE SOMETIMES COLLECT CARDBOARD AND PLASTICS IN A SEPARATE TRUCK ****

MATERIALS MUST BE SORTED BY CATEGORY WITHIN YOUR CURBSIDE BIN BY USING BAGS, DIVIDERS, OR SEPARATE BINS FOR EACH MATERIAL. MATERIALS NOT PROPERLY PREPARED WILL BE LEFT AT THE CURB!

Special Collections:

Spring Cleanup: Held during May. Free drop-off at the sewer plant or picked up curbside for a fee by NTSWA

Yard Waste: Call the Borough office at (570) 265-2696 to pre-arrange drop-off at the old Bridge St. Landfill

Leaves: Drop off at Elm St. during October & November. Bagged leaves picked up curbside in November

Christmas Trees: Collection times to be announced in January

FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES WHEN RECYCLING PLASTIC. NOT ALL PLASTICS ARE RECYCLABLE

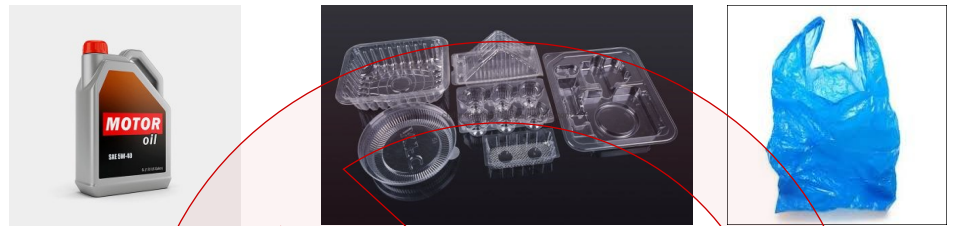

Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Jars, & Tubs: Recycle these container shapes only. Includes soda and water bottles, shampoo bottles, milk and laundry jugs, and yogurt and butter tubs. **NO FOOD RESIDUE.** Labels and caps can remain.

****Crushing plastic containers helps save space. Bagging plastics for curbside pick up is ACCEPTABLE.**

NO STYROFOAM, NO OIL CONTAINERS, NO BULKY/HARD OR RIGID PLASTICS, NO FLOWER POTS, NO BLACK PLASTIC, NO PLASTIC BAGS, NO CLAMSHELLS, NO MICROWAVE TRAYS, NO TAKEOUT CONTAINERS, NO BERRY/BAKERY CONTAINERS, NO PLASTIC PACKAGING, NO TOYS, NO HANGERS, NO PLASTIC FURNITURE. WHEN IN DOUBT, THROW IT OUT!

****Materials will be left behind if we cannot accept them for recycling or they were too dirty and should be disposed of.**
